## Player/Supporter CODE OF CONDUCT

As a part of the Mountain View Soccer Program, you realize that your actions and words represent yourself, your family, the Mountain View Soccer Program, and Mountain View High School. As a program, we strive to provide a good example and representation of the program. The following rules apply to all parents and players.

1. Spectators, parents, and guests are not allowed at practices or games. This includes at the field, or on school premises outside of vehicle. If dropping off or picking up a player, please remain in your vehicle.
2. Face masks are required by all players at all times upon arrival to the facility. Clear plastic face shields are not appropriate for athletic practices and contests. Social distancing requirements will be followed when possible.
3. Respect the playing of the game and the efforts of all participants during contests.
4. Treat officials as persons of integrity and qualification, and respect their decisions.
5. Respect all players, coaches, and officials, regardless of team loyalty. Mountain View Girls Soccer players and parents will exhibit great sportsmanship.
6. The use of name calling, harassment, and/or badgering is prohibited and will result in your dismissal from the premises.
7. Mountain View Girls Soccer Program requires a "24 Hour Reflection Period" after contests. Any concern regarding the contest can be **scheduled** and addressed 24 hours after the contest is completed.
8. All parents, spectators, and participants will adhere to this Code Of Conduct, Mountain View High School Rules and Policies, Bend-LaPine District Rules, and OSAA state regulations during contests and practices.
9. If an issue arises, a player or parent must first address the issue with that player's assigned coach. If the problem cannot be resolved, the varsity coach will be contacted. If the problem persists proper administration will be involved to resolve the issue.
